



Alternative effective dates for vaccination:			
• WA: The effective vaccination dates for WA align with State Government public health orders:			



- Exposed port / vessel / vessel contact workers will be required to have their first vaccination dose by 15 October 2021 and be fully vaccinated by 12 November 2021.	
 All other workers will be required to have their first vaccination dose by 1 December 2021, and to be fully vaccinated by 1 January 2022. 	
• NSW : Considering the current COVID-19 outbreak in NSW and the State Government plan to ease restrictions, workers and visitors to BHP workplaces in NSW will be required to have their first vaccination dose by 10 November 2021 and be fully vaccinated by 31 January 2022.	
If further adjustments to the date are required for specific locations, separate information will be provided.	
For vaccines currently approved in Australia, a vaccinated individual is someone who has received both doses of a COVID-19 vaccine. Beyond this, additional vaccination requirements may be defined if recommended by the Australian Technical Advisory Group on Immunisation (ATAGI).	
This decision has not been made lightly and we appreciate that not everyone will agree, though we strongly believe this is the right path to protect the health and safety of our workforce, their families, and the communities where we operate, including remote Indigenous communities near our operations.
